Students can also visit two of the major Universities in Queensland.

Brisbane Walkabout

We begin with a group photograph overlooking the Brisbane city; walk through Queen Street Mall visiting souvenir shops; cross Victoria Bridge and the Brisbane River with a short visit at the Museum; walk through beautiful Southbank Parklands and stop for lunch at the beach; continue over the Goodwill Bridge and visit the Queensland University of Technology (QUT) campus; walk through the Botanical Gardens. This walking tour is nearly four kilometres.

An opportunity to visit beautiful Gold Coast beaches for a walk and play time on golden sands. The Gold Coast consists of 70 kms of coastline with some of the most popular surf breaks in Australia and the world. We may be able to talk to a professional life saver. 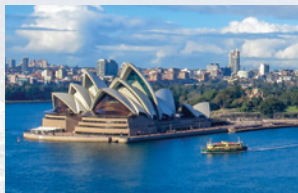


Sydney Day Trip

Activities include aspects of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander cultures, both traditional and contemporary such as the Dreamtime, gathering good, boomerang throwing, didgeridoo, throwing sticks and traditional painting methods.



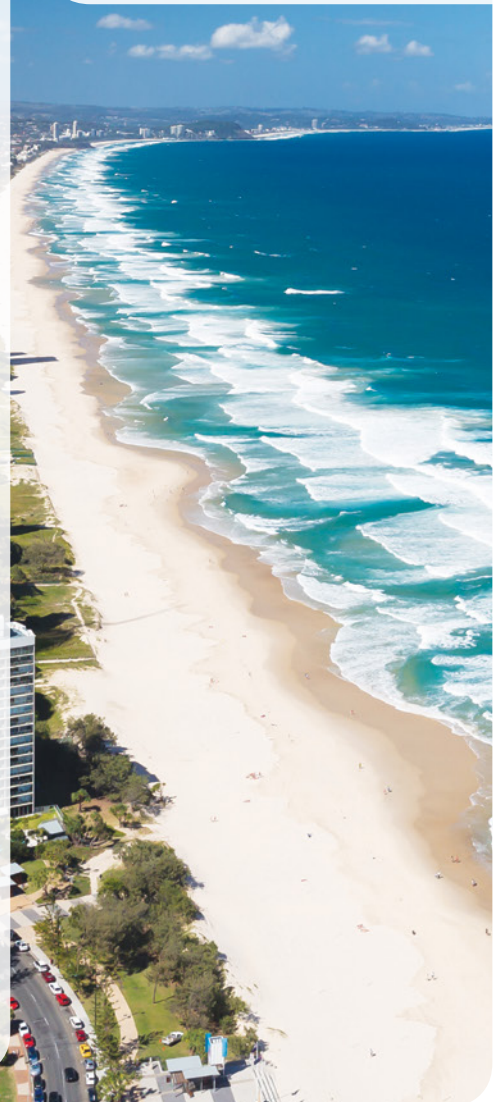

Activities include horse care, rainforest walks, feeding animals, milking cows, water divining and bush cooking.



Currumbin Wildlife Sanctuary

Currumbin Wildlife Sanctuary is world renowned for the multitude of events, shows and attractions include dingo encounters, free flight bird shows and even crocodile feeding of the park's massive saltwater crocodile.

This visit is an opportunity for students to cuddle a koala and have their photo taken, to feed kangaroos, to handle snakes and to enjoy all the wildlife of Australia in one place.
